

COMMANDERS DIARIES INSTRUCTIONS

AIM

1. The aim of a Commanders Diary is to provide data on which to base future improvements in Army training, equipment, organization and administration, and to furnish historians with a record of the activities of units and formations in operational and non-operational periods in peace and in war.

GENERAL

- 2. Entries are to be made daily on AF C 2118 (Adapted) each entry being initialled by the officer detailed to keep it.
- 3. Commanders Diaries will conform with the rules for drafting orders given in "Staff Duties (Australia)" Chapter 2, Section 12.

RESPONSIBILITY

During Non-operational Periods

4. A Commanders Diary is to be compiled by commanders of all formations.

During Operational Periods (1)

- 5. A Commanders Diary is to be compiled in duplicate by:
 - a. Commanders of all formations.
 - b. Each branch of the staff at formation headquarters commanded by a brigadier or above.
 - c. Heads of services not below the rank of lieutenant colonel.
 - d. Personal staffs and officers holding special appointments.
 - e. Unit commanders.
 - f. Commanders of a detachment of a unit when so ordered.

COMPILATION

- 6. Both original and duplicate copies are to consist of:
 - a. Cover (AF C 2119) (Adapted).
 - b. Index as printed on cover.
 - c. Narrative (AF C 2118) (Adapted).
 - d. Annexes as shown in the Index.
- 7. All details of the unit or formation (if a detachment is concerned, the name of the parent unit), period covered and enclosure numbers of the annexes are to be shown on the cover. If there has been a change of command since the last report, the date of assumption by the new commanding officer is to be included.
- 8. The annexes are to be assembled in the groups shown on the cover. If there are no enclosures for an annex NIL will be entered on the cover. If additional annexes are convenient for a particular headquarters, tarting at B.

DISPOSAL

- 13. Original Commander's Diary. This is to be foorwarded monthly, unless otherwise ordered, by the seventh day of the succeeding month direct to AHQ.
- 14. Duplicate Commander's Diary. This must be clearly marked as a duplicate. It is to be sent separately from the original to AHQ one month after the original has been despatched but not before the former has been acknowledged.
- 15. When overseas, both copies of diaries are to be sent through the Army Records organization in the overseas theatre but at different times.

16. TOP SECRET Supplementary Diaries.

- a. The documents referred to in Paragraph 9 together with a list of them made out on AF C 2118 (Adapted) must be placed in separate cover (AF C 2119) (Adapted). All details must be filled in and the cover clearly marked in red: "ANNEX Z OFFICER ONLY". It may be convenient to group the papers by appendices.
- b. Supplementary diaries must be forwarded under the normal rules for TOP SECRET correspondence, to AHQ. The inner enevelope must be plainly marked:

- e. Where unaccompanied baggage of members serving overseas is being forwarded to Australia, it will be inspected by MFO, or the responsible officer concerned, prior to its acceptance for despatch. Any unauthorized firearms or explosives will be removed.
- f. When any member is charged with an offence in respect of any act, conduct or omission described by this instruction, the offence will not be dealt with summarily without the approval of superior authority.

Torrain.

Area covered consisted of undulating country with fairly low canopy (20 ft), with patches of thick undergrowth but in the main fairly open. Vision in the main 100 yds.

Area interlaced by foot and animal pads most of which run NORTH - SOUTH.

G. En.

GR572668 at 161835H. Well used bullock trk running EAST - WEST. 7 x 112 lbs of bamboo shoots found on side of trk. Shoots had been cut in vic. Several small footpads ran from vic of bamboo SOUTH.

GR578665 at 170830H. Area where palm leaves had been cut and taken away. Not more than week old. Trk led SOUTH from area of cuttings. Also in area of cuttings old cache approx 2 weeks old found. Size, 12 ft x 6 ft x 12 ft deep. Cache was empty and palm leaves had been used to cover it.

GR58056645 at 170945H. Cough heard 100 metres to WEST. 2 minutes later ptl contacted 1 VC on old footpad. En fled SOUTH when ordered to halt by ptl. Ptl then fired on him, results unknown, area was checked and NO bloodstains were found. Dress of en, black pyjamas. NO wpn or web eqpt observed.

At 170950H. 50 metres to EAST well used exeart trk located. Trk used by bullock cart 4 - 5 days previously and by 4 - 5 men about 2 hrs prior. En wearing BATA boots and sandals. Group had moved NORTH.

Whilst crossing trk ptl had contact with 2 armed VC moving NORTH with wpnd slung. Both en fell to the ground but 1 was seen to get up and run away. En KIA was wearing black pyjamas, Ho Chi Minh sandals and webbing. The other VC wore greens and a bush hat similar to Aust patt. Bloodstains were found where en WIA fell.

Ptl recovered 1 x Kar '98, Manser rifle (German)(1 rd half chambered).
Web belt, black poncho, water bottle.

At 170955H. 2 rifle shots heard. 1,300 metres to NORTH, the other 400 metres to EAST.







F. Terrain.

Ground undulating, covered in primary jungle with a carpet of thick secondary growth. All re entrants encountered by ptl were very steep and thickly covered in brambles and vines. Going was very difficult and slow.

G. En.

YS583725 at 171830H. Signal shots heard from area of LZ 10 mins after ptl landed and deployed. Both SA and MG fire.

YS576733 at 180930H. Approx 10 en, both sexes, heard moving SW on old SW - NE bullock cart trk. All en talked voluably, laughed, giggled and gave every indication that they felt secure in the area.

YS567738 at 191330H. As ptl were climbing a small knoll a signal shot was fired approx 15 yds to their front. Ptl wdr then investigated area where shot came from. Sounds of digging and chopping were heard and many signs of pits being dug and OHP being cut were observed. Attap had been cut from the area and removed, also secondary growth cleared.

YS566732 at 181400H. Ptl circumnavigated feature which en were busy fortifying. The pits on the lower slopes were completed and had OHP. Approx 1 pl plus were working in abovementiones areas, both sexes.

YS566734 at 181415H. Rattle of dixies and smell of food cooking indicated that the en units living area was in this loc.

YS574706 at 211430H. 6 armed en seen moving SE on foot trk running NW - SE. Dress, black pyjamas ans black hats, footwear not observed. All carried large full '37 type packs. Wpns carried slung, not identified. En moving swiftly but nontactically, talking and making plenty of noise. Their neat appearance suggested that they had not travelled far and that they had just embarked on their journey.

H. Map Corrections.

> Many deep ravines and re entrants which are not marked on maps were encountered by ptl. throughout the whole area.

I. Misc Info.

Many SA and AW shots were heard by the ptl throughout the area.

Nearly every spurline encountered by the ptl had a small well used foot trk running down it.

In the Western part of the ptl area allied bombing has been so intense that going is vecy difficult indeed through the shattered tree trunks and fallen vegetation.

Conclusions and Recommendations.

It is recommended that further SAS ptls in the area be of at least 6 men. The area is limited in LZ spaces and should a contact occur maximum fire power is likely to be required to ensure the safe extraction of the ptl.

There are a great number of en in the area and they are using all trks freely.

It is recommended that should a ptl miss 2 consequetive scheds whilst working in this area a fly over search be conducted immediately rather than waiting until the next sched time.

It seems apparent that there are considerable numbers of en in the ptl area making excellent tgts for airstrikes etc.

The very heavy, thick, scrub in the area would not lend its self to BH or larger sized operations against the en.


