PART I - G MATTERS

GENERAL

1. Location A Sect 1 Topo Svy Tp remained in 1 ATF Base

SURVEY SECTION.

- 2. a. Field Work
 - (1) The following field annotation for photomaps and map revision was completed:
 - (a) 2 Oct Sgt STRUNKS and Spr OFFER continued amoutation of LONG HAI.
 - (b) 8 Oct Maj CONSTANTINE, Sgt STRUNKS, Cpl KHIGHT and Spr GILBERT annotated PHUOC TIMH and PHUOC LAM.
 - (2) The levelling task for the Province Engineer Adviser was completed. The task consisted of taking a level from a third order NGS bench mark in the Province HQ courtyard to the pumping station at YS 382629, 2KH FORTH of BA RIA. A profile of the SONG DINH as the pumping station was also produced. See Annexures E and F attached.
 - (3) The centre line of LUSCOMDE strip was marked.
 - (4) The layout of an aerial for 547 Sig Tp was completed.

b. Compilation.

- (1) Map revision continued. Map revision data was overprinted on maps supplied for 6 RAR OP ROSS and 5 RAR OP KINGS CROSS.
- (2) A mosaic of HOA LONG from USARV Project 52 photography was commenced.
- (3) A reprint of the 1:100,000 1 ATF Special Overprint was prepared. It was found that the areas of land clearance had to be further reclassified to show "areas of significant regrowth". See para 3.b.(3) below.

(4) 1:5,000 air photography was received from HQ UNARY M & I Division. The coverage was from DAT DO along route 44 to PHUOC HAI, DAT DO WEST to the BARIA complex and part of route 15 from CHU H.I to PHUOC HOA. The photography was good quality but a full coverage of DAT DO was not flown.

CARTOGRAPHIC AND REPRODUCTION SECTIONS.

3. a. Operational Tasks

- (1) Prepared Stock The overprinting of stock with map revision data and enemy installations data continued.
- (2) Battle Int Quarterly Update. L7014 series (1:50,000) maps were overprinted with map revision data, enemy installations and mine data for the routine quarterly update. The following maps were overprinted:
 - (a) 6430-I
 - (b) 6430-II
 - (c) 6430-III
 - (d) 6430-IV
 - (e) 6429-I
 - (f) 6129-IV
 - (g) 6530-III
- (3) 6 RAR CO ROSS Overprints showing map revision data, enemy installations, mine data and tactical information were drawn and overprinted onto L7014 series (1:50,000) maps 6430-II and 6429-I. 80 dyeline copies of the AO boundary were supplied as an annex to the Op Instr. See Annex G attached.
- (4) 5 RAR OP KINGS CROSS Overprints showing map revision data, enemy installations, mine data and tactical information were drawn and overprinted onto L701; selies (1:50,000) maps 6430-III, 6430-IV and 6330-II. 80 dyeline copies of the AO boundary were supplied as an annex to the Op Instr. See Annex H attached.
- (5) 5 PAR OP KINGSTON The AO for 5 RAR OP KINGSTON was extended at short notice. Maps overprinted with revision data were supplied from stock. Transparent dyelines of enemy installations and mine data were also supplied.

b. Manning Tanks.

- (1) NUI DAT (1:10,000) Special Edition 4 of the NUI DAT (1:10,000) Special is being prepared for printing.
- (2) TAOR Overprint Repromat is being prepared to overprint the revised TAOR detail, in two colours on L7014 series (1:50,000) maps 6430-I-II-III-IV, 6429-I and 6530-III.

- (3) 1 ATF Special Overprint The L607 series (1:100,000) maps 6430 and 6530 printed last month (See Op Report No 41, para 3.b.(1)) were well received and stocks are now exhausted. The sheets are to be reprinted with minor changes to specifications and land clearance is to be shown in three categories ie: land clearance, areas of significant regrowth and areas replanted.
- (4) 1 ATF Area of Operations. The 1 ATF Area of Operation 1:500,000 map was printed for the Sect by 66th Engr Coy (Topo). See Annex D attached.
- c. Miscellaneous Hand Lettering and Charts.
 - (1) A 1:50,000 map assembly was produced for GS02 (Ops) showing TAORs for surrounding formations.
 - (2) A film distribution chart was drawn for the Amenities Officer.
 - (3) A list of office bearers was drawn for HQ 1 ATF Officers' Mess.
- d. Miscellaneous Drawing and Reproduction Tasks.

- e. Printing. Full details of all printing during the pariod are shown at Annex A.
- f. Thotography. The following tasks were completed in ddition to routine work in support of the Cartographic Section.
 - (1) Super enlargements were made of the following areas to support D/6 RAR and 3/52 ARVN operations
 - (a) Part of DAT DO Ten bromide copies from stock photography.
 - (b) NUI NHON Ten bromide copies from stock photography.
 - (c) Part of PHUOC LOI and HOI MY Ten bromides from hand held photography especially flown for the operation.
 - (2) One copy of each print of the 1:25,000 photography within the battalion base patrol AOs was supplied to each appropriate battalion and ARU. The prints were enlarged to 1:12,500. A total of 104 prints were made at 18" x 18".
 - (3) The 1:25,000 photography to the area WEST of BINH BA was twice enlarged and three copies of each of three prints were supplied to Battle Int for ratrols.
 - (4) A mine damaged tank of B Sqn 1 Armd Regt was photographed, nine copies of each of seven prints were supplied.

- (5) Three copies of the 1 ALSG mosaic were produced; two for HQ AFV and one for 2 AOD.
- (6) Part of DAT DO was enlarged for 5 RAR OP ROSS Three bromide prints were supplied.
- (7) Ten bromide copies of an enlarged portion of LONG SON on the L8015 series (1:25,000) map were supplied to 1 Aust CA Unit to plot the water reticulation system.
- (8) A project has been commenced to supply air photographs of all minefields within the Province for HQ AFV. During October 244 prints were produced. This figure was the coverage for 61 minefields, four copies of each. The task continues.
- (9) A RAAOC plaque was enlarged for 2 AOD and one bromide print supplied.
- (10) Aerial photographs of the DAT DO barrier minefield were supplied to 1 Fd Sqn. Four copies of each of 23 originals were supplied.
- (11) Two copies of the LONG HAI, PHUOC TINH, LO VOI and PHUOC LAM mosaics were supplied to ARVN Training Cadre at LONG HAI.
- (12) A film was processed and prints made of four VC suspects for HOA LONG MATS team.
