OPERATIONAL REPORT NO 64 COVERING PERIOD 1-31 AUG 71

General

The Unit remained at 1 ATF Base NUI DAT. It is planned for the Unit to cease operation on 1 Oct 71 and to depart NUI DAT on 8 Oct 71. The Unit is expected to travel by air with stores and equipment moving by sea.
