- 2. Various reliable sources including the Assistant Company Commander of the LONG DAT District Coy C25 who rallied on 8 Dec 66 have revealed the following VC activities in the area of Route 23.
  - a. Group 84 purchasing agencies operate in PHUOC LOI, HOI MY, DAT DO and PHUOC HAI. The first named being the most important.
  - b. Supplies are stored in areas close by the villages named in para 2.a. above and are moved:
    - (1) Via Route 52 to the vicinity of LONG TAN.
    - (2) Via Route 23 to vicinity YS 530614.
    - (3) Via various tracks to vicinity YS 535565 and YS 555575 to the SONG RAI.
  - c. VC oxen and ox-carts are permanently located near the SONG RAI in the vicinity YS 570600.
  - d. Various VC units have been employed on rice carrying tasks across Route 23 in the area of YS 588637. This is thought to be the main area through which supplies from DAT DO/P.IUOC HAI are moved to the NORTH.
- 3. On a number of accassions a main force battalion has been employed on a rice carrying task in the area SOUTH of Route 23. This could re occur at any time but there are no indications that it is happening at present.
- 4. A list of VC sightings, contacts and bases is at Appx 1.

# GENERAL ENEMY USE OF THE AREA

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1. AN NHUT lies in the centre of the richest rice producing area of PHUOC TUY. Consequently it plays an important role in the provision of supplies for the 5th VC Division and for D445 Battalion. Its proximity to the LONG HAI hills has made it one of the support bases for the C 25 (LONG DAT) District Company. AN NHUT is sited in an excellent position for gathering information on both LONG DIEN and DAT DO District Head quarters and VC intelligence elements have been reported in the village from time to time.

# ENEMY ACTIVITIES IN AN NHUT

- 2. It is thought that some thirty members of the village have been engaged in hostile activities. Several men are away with D 445 Battalion and others with C 25 Company. The VC village organisation includes a food protection cell, a proselytising cell, a women's cell and a guerilla squad. The guerilla squad is supported by a labour section, a recruit section and a provision section. The squads main task is recomaissance for D 445 Battalion. The squad has a rendezvous at CAY DA (YS 465620). The LONG DAT VC District Party Committee runs annual reorientation courses at MINH DAM mountain (YS 458536) usually in June and July. Attendance at these courses has been obligatory for all active VC in AP NHUT. On 19 Nov 66 the village chief of AN NHUT was murdered by the VC.

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
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

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

#### EN FORCES

- AN NHUT is on the fringe of the GVN controlled area of PHUOC TUY, but is largely VC dominated. Domination is maintained by a continuous VC presence in and around the village, and the local RF Coy has become ineffective. The VC forces hich have made this possible are:
  - a. D445 Bn which has operated extensively in the area around AN NHUT and was positively located in the area as recently as 17 Dec 66. There have been many reports of this unit being in the area since the beginning of Feb 67.
  - b. The LONG DAT District Coy C25. The organisation of this company is shown at Appendix 1. This company is usually located in the LONG HAI Peniasulas
  - c. The AN NHUT village VC organisation (Appendix 2). Little is known of this infrastructure, however, strength of the guerilla squad is believed to be about 10.
- 2. In addition to these VC forces the village contains mapy families and friends of VC soldiers who live outside the village. These people are largely VC sympathisers and contribute to the overall VC hold on the village.
- 3. VC activities in the AN NHUT area have been:
  - Acts of terrorism such as the murder of the hamlet chief on 19 Nov 66; an increase in these activities was ordered by the District Committee as recently as Jan 67.
  - b. Destruction of roads and bridges.
  - c. Collection of intelligence.
  - d. Collection of food and other supplies.
  - e. Collection of taxes.
- 4. Members of VC units who have families in AN NHUT are thought to visit their families regularly and this is likely to have increased over the current TET holiday period.
- Friendly forces operating in the area of AN NHUT are likely to make contact with AN NHUT village guerillas, guerillas from other villages in the area, and members of Group 84. Contact with the regional coy C25 and D445 Bn is also possible but it is unlikely that these forces will seek a major battle. VC initiated incidents are likely to be limited to sniping, booby trapping and mining, particularly of withdrawal routes.


ORG OF C25 (Str 100)

- 1. a. The LONG HAI peninsular is astride the border between the two GVN districts of LONG DIEN and DAT DO. This location coupled with the ruggedness of the terrain make it an ideal VC base. In addition the area dominates and provides easy access to the surrounding rice, fish and salt producing areas.
  - b. The peninsular is the centre of the VC district of LONG DAT.
- 2. a. VC Forces normally operating in the area are:

D445 Bn C25 Coy Tam Phuoc Guerilla Platoon Hoi My Guerilla Platoon Phuoc Hai Guerilla Platoon

- b. Latest reports indicate that D445 Bn is now operating as independent companies and if this is so one company will certainly be based in the LONG HAI peninsular area.
- c. The C25 Coy is permanently located in the LONG HAI mountains and recent activity suggests that it is probably based in square YS4752. It could however be based along the other main water source in the area in vicinity YS4655.
- a. The heavily populated area astride Route 44 to the East of the peninsular has been subjected to more VC activity in the last three months than any other area in PHUOC TUY Province. This commenced on 21 Nov 66 with a series of attacks and mortarings of the RF/PF outposts in the area by D445 Bn supported by C25 Coy. This series of attacks terminated on 17 Dec 66 but since that date there have been continual reports of VC activities in the area, and during the TET standown period there were several contacts and sightings of up to two VC ocys. All these activities are believed to have originated from VC bases on the Eastern side of the LONG HAI mountain range.
  - b. Other significant VC activity in the area was on the night of 27 Jan 67 when a US Navy small craft received MG fire from YS480500 and YS472482. On the same night a large signalling fire was observed at YS480500 and VC signalling lights were seen between this location and LANG PHUOC HAI at YS5153. These activities are thought to be part of a securing operation while a VC infiltration operation was conducted over the beach further to the East. It is possible however that the VC forces involved were providing early warning to other VC located in the LONG HAI area.
  - c. Appx 1 shows the major VC installations contacts and sightings in the area.
- 4. No FWMAF have operated in the mountains since June 66 and at that time local VC forces inflicted moderate casualties on friendly forces by sniping and booby trapping while suffering only light casualties themselves. During this operation the VC withdrew from their main bases near the creeks to caves in the mountains where they are believed to have hidden until the end of the operation. This action is likely to be repeated during any similar operation by ARVN or FWMAF. The numerous caves in the area are similar to those encountered in the NUI THI VAI Mountains.
- 5. No mainforce VC are thought to be in the area and contact with main force is unlikely.


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

#### ENEMY

#### General

- 1. The LONG HAI hills have been used as a base and refuge by the VC for many years. From their security the VC have extended their influence out over DAT DO and LONG LE Districts to the extent that in 1965, the VC controlled the two districts. Since mid 1966, the VC have been pushed back into the hills by Allied operations and by the strengthening of local administration over the villages in the two districts. Their bases in the hills have been located and pounded by airstrikes and artillery. It now remains to complete the destruction of all VC facilities in the LONG HAI hills.
- This company was recruited from the several villages which surround the hills by the LONG DAT VC District Committee. The LONG DAT VC District comprises LONG DIEN and DAT DO districts and was formed to coordinate and control the local area. The C 25 Company has provided security for the LONG DAT District Headquarters, it has ambushed, mined and dug up Routes 44, 326 and 23, it has raided Government outposts and terrorised officials. Until late 1966, armed members of C 25 Company could often be sighted in villages by day. Now they operate in villages only at night.
- The Provincial Mobile Battalion (D 445) has come to use the DAT DO District as its main area of operations. It has utilised the bases and sanctuary of the LONG HAI hills on many operations during the past six months. However, D 445 Battalion has not made the LONG HAI hills its main base, nor has it always had one or more companies in the hills.
- During June 1966, 173 Airborne Brigade swept through the LONG HAI hills on Operation HOLLANDIA, finding several base camps but without locating large numbers of enemy. However, those who were encountered in isolated clashes were skilful enough to inflict by small arms what we would term heavy casualties. However Operation HOLLANDIA provided valuable information on VC bases and these have been struck on several occasions since by shells and bombs.
- Enemy activity in the LONG HAI hills flared up in December 1966 with a number of attacks made by C 25 Company and D 445 Battalion on villages such as TAM PHUOC, PHUOC HAI, HOI MY, PHUOC LOI and DAT DO. Many of these attacks were supported by 60 mm and 81 mm mortar fire. A number of ARVN operations, air strikes and a 6 RAR sweep were mounted against the VC in the hills and caused many enemy casualties. Since then, VC acts of violence in the LONG DAT area have been few. During TET, the VC advertised their presence by flying large flags near LONG MY and another flag on the main southern peak of the hills, NUI CHAU VIEN, which was illuminated for the occasion by a spotlight.
- During the past few days, A Sqn 3 Cav Regt have swept through the low country on the eastern side of the hills, encountering no VC, but several tracks indicating recent presence of enemy in small groups. Two companies of D445 Battalion were reported in the southern area of the hills in early February but because the area has been heavily bombarded it is not likely that these companies are still WEST of PHUOC HAI.

## Approaches to the LONG HAI Hills

Because Routes 44, 23 and 326 are such obvious approaches to the hills they receive frequent attention from the VC. Excavations, mines and booby traps are common in the area. Road blocks appear on both the western and eastern arms of Route 44 the southern section has been keyholed to make it impassable and the TUNG Bridge (YS 498509) has been demolished. Route 326 has been mined at several points along its length. The section between YS 462577 and YS 468573 has been excavated in several places to make the road impassable. However vehicles may move around these cuts on the dry paddy fields. Booby traps are likely to be encountered anywhere in the area of operation.

#### Likely Enemy to be Encountered

9. The frequency of air strikes and artillery bombardments and the current scarcity of water make it unlikely that either C 25 Company or any company of D 445 Battalion will be found in the hills during this operation. Some members of either unit may be present to conduct liaison and intelligence missions. If these are encountered they will attempt to harass our own troops and then escape.

#### Likely Enemy Reactions

10. Any sizeable VC unit (platoon or company) will go into a counter sweep operation, taking evasive action except where it is possible to lead our troops into an ambush or onto booby traps. Individual VC will probably reconnoitre company base camps at night. The C 25 company has access to both claymores and 60 mm mortars.

/ 11. The gun area

11. The gun area and battalion headquarters are exposed to an appreciable risk of mortar bombardment from the VC base area in YS 5157. Both the static nature of the headquarters and the exposed position must offer one of the most tempting targets which the VC have ever had in this area. At the present time it is likely that D 445 Battalion does not have its mortars within easy access of the area. However if they are within convenient distance area GERTRUDE must prepare to be harassed in the same manner in which every Government outpost in the area has been harassed in recent months.





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

- 1. A usually reliable agent reported that on 20 Feb 67 the 274 Regt would move to the EAST probably to the area YS 5685. The purpose of this move was allegedly to join up with the VC 5th Div, but could be a purely defensive move to escape probable future US/FWMAF operations in the HAT DICH area.
- 2. There was some confirmation of this move on the night 20/21 Feb 67 when a light aircraft twice observed a small number of lights SOUTH of BINH GIA (YS 4977). Closer observation of these lights with a Starlight Scope revealed approximately 250 lights on each occasion. The lights appeared to be moving to the east and were quickly extinguished when lightly engaged by heavy artillery.
- A recent rallier, the political officer from THUA TICH (YS6081) area, revealed that on 14 Feb 61 the Comd of the VC 5th Div stayed overnight in the vicinity of his village. This is an unusual occurrence, but another reliable agent stated that an element of the 5th Div HQ has been in the vicinity YS 6286 since
- 4. 275 Regt is known to have been in the same general area EAST of THUA TICH since some time after its unsuccessful ambush on Highway 1 on 2 Dec 66 when it suffered more than 100 KIA. The regiment should have recovered from this incident by now and indications are that it could now be ready to resume operations.
- s. In his note book captured on 19 Oct 66 the Chief of Staff 274 Regt recorded the contents of a recently received message from 5th VC Div that future plans included combined operations between 274 Regt and 275 Regt. The fact that 274 Regt now appears to have moved to a location close to 275 Regt and elements of Headquarters 5th VC Div is the first indication that these forces may be preparing for a combined operation. A combined operation at this stage would probably be restricted to two separate but coordinated actions, such as an attack in one location followed by the ambush of a relief force. An operation of this sort specifically mentioned in the note book captured on 19 Oct 66. The targets were not named but thhe area given was Route 2 NORTH of the 1 ATF base camp and this must be considered a likely area. A VC operation against the 1 ATF base camp is possible whenever two battalions and supporting units are away on operations but is unlikely whenever the major part of the base camp is occupied.

I believe this has been largely a month of "no change" so I am not able to find much to write about. The operations which have been conducted have been in areas where communications have been straight forward.

#### Radio

We have now received our AN/PRC-64 sets and batteries. The sets were taken out by 5 RAR on it's last operation to try them out and to familiarise operators. However, conditions were too simple to provide any real test so I shall have to try again next time.

#### Signal Centre

The cipher office is now complete and has been occupied. Except for minor improvements and Tinishing off" the building is now complete. I had a set of photographs taken showing the building generally and various aspects of the installation and have sent these to D Sigs separately.

I will attach to this letter an example of our daily traffic statistics as at Peb 67. The methods used for recording in the message and despatch sections of the form are semawhat different. In the message section, movement between HQ 1 ATF and the siggen is not recorded so that the "in" and "out" sides represent separate messages between the siggen and some locations separate from HQ 1 ATF. The average total daily number of messages handled is therefore about 300. In the despatch section, the SDS office is treated as a separate entity and all despatches are counted in and out regardless of where they go to. This means that the "in" and "out" sides should balance except for despatches held in the SDS office overnight. The average daily number of despatches handled is therefore about 325.

#### Camp construction

Progress has been slow this month as there is a shortage of concrete mixers in Engineers due to breakdowns. The floor for the Squadron headquarters building is about three-quarters laid and we are now again waiting for the concrete mixer.
