COMMANDERS DIARIES INSTRUCTIONS

AIM

1. The aim of a Commanders Diary is to provide data on which to base future improvements in Army training, equipment, organization and administration, and to furnish historians with a record of the activities of units and formations in operational and non-operational periods in peace and in war.

GENERAL

- 2. Entries are to be made daily on AF C 2118 (Adapted) each entry being initialled by the officer detailed to keep it.
- 3. Commanders Diaries will conform with the rules for drafting orders given in "Staff Duties (Australia)", Chapter 2, Section 12.

RESPONSIBILITY

During Non-operational Periods

4. A Commanders Diary is to be compiled by commanders of all formations.

During Operational Periods (1)

- 5. A Commanders Diary is to be compiled in duplicate by:
 - a. Commanders of all formations.
 - b. Each branch of the staff at formation headquarters commanded by a brigadier or above.
 - c. Heads of services not below the rank of lieutenant colonel.
 - d. Personal staffs and officers holding special appointments.
 - e. Unit commanders.
 - f. Commanders of a detachment of a unit when so ordered.

COMPILATION

- 6. Both original and duplicate copies are to consist of:
 - a. Cover (AF C 2119) (Adapted).
 - b. Index as printed on cover.
 - c. Narrative (AF C 2118) (Adapted).
 - d. Annexes as shown in the Index.
- 7. All details of the unit or formation (if a detachment is concerned, the name of the parent unit), period covered and enclosure numbers of the annexes are to be shown on the cover. If there has been a change of command since the last report, the date of assumption by the new commanding officer is to be included.
- 8. The annexes are to be assembled in the groups shown on the cover. If there are no enclosures for an annex NIL will be entered on the cover. If additional annexes are convenient for a particular headquarters.

- 15. When overseas, both copies of diaries are to be sent through the Army Records organization in the overseas theatre but at different times.
- 16. TOP SECRET Supplementary Diaries.
 - a. The documents referred to in Paragraph 9 together with a list of them made out on AF C 2118 (Adapted) must be placed in separate cover (AF C 2119) (Adapted). All details must be filled in and the cover clearly marked in red: "ANNEX Z OFFICER ONLY". It may be convenient to group the papers by appendices.
 - b. Supplementary diaries must be forwarded under the normal rules for TOP SECRET correspondence, to AHQ. The inner envelope must be plainly marked:



The school at LONG HOA was also recently damage by a booby trap, and the village chief and his family were killed probably by mines placed against his house in LONG HOA in late Feb 71.
- b. The roads to the EAST and WEST of AO MELBOURNE have been repeatedly mined this year and all culverts must be treated with caution.

- c. Light attacks by fire including use of mors have been made against the PF Pl posts at PHUMY, LONG HOA and MT STUART demonstrating the QC, ability to organise and execute attacks over a scattered areas.
- d. Comment: The enemy units operating in the AO possibly have a tase located centrally in the high ground GS 9072. They could make use of natural routes downreentrants and spur lines to the civilian population centres, to carry out attacks by fire.



 - b. Movement of individuals in and out of LONG HOA, generally by night.

TOPOGRAPHY, POPULATION SURVEY AND METEOROLOGY

Popography

The village of LONG HOA is situated at GR 853714, it is bounded to the NORTH by a creek and is similarly bounded to the SOUTH by a branch of that creek. A major road runs NORTH-SOUTH to the WEST of the village near the branch in the creek. There is a large 500 by 150M clearing to the NORTH-EAST of the village and there is generally gently sloping ground to the village with a road running to the east of the village partially along this extremity to PF Post.

Population General

- 2. LONG HOA had a population of up to 1200 people however QC acts of terrorism, the drift of the younger people to jobs in the larger towns and the government draft programme has reduced this number to no more than 200.
- The main religions followed are Buddism, CAO DAI and Roman Catholicism.

Local Situation

- 4. The villagers are mainly farmers, with some local tradesmen and woodcutters. General produce is sold in the markets at PHU MY.
- The attitude of the population is basically apathetic, though a slight swing to the RSQ government has recently been reported. The people are naturally most concerned about their own village and local district.
- 6. Some villagers are known to have relatives with the QC and are sympathetic to their aims.
- 7. Known QC infrastructure in the village is shown in ANNEX A to this OPO.


Local Government Forces

- 8. LONG HOA is protected by one popular forces (PF) platoon of 25 soldiers which is equiped with 1 by 105 mm How. The PF is protected by a fenced protective minefield.
- 9. There are no known records of any previous cordon and search conducted by RSQ forces.

Curfew/Access Area

10. Curfew is not imposed inside the village but the normal curfew (1830 - 0600hrs) exists in the own risks civil access area.

- 11. QC access routes to the village could possibly be mined and a protective mine field has been layed around the PF post.

Population Survey

There are no cencus figures available for the village after 1969. The estimated breakup 45% female, 30% children and 25% male occupation. There is no known percentage of males eligible for military service.
