Re 30A Pte.W.Burrows, 14th A.S.C. He was admitted as a patient to this Hpl. on the 3-9-18. He was put under special observation and received every care and attention. In spite of all that the Medical Officer and nurses could do for him he passed away quietly at 11-30 on the night of the 9-9-18, suffering from Pyaemia. He was buried at St. Sever Cemetery on the 11-9-18, grave No. is 6287.

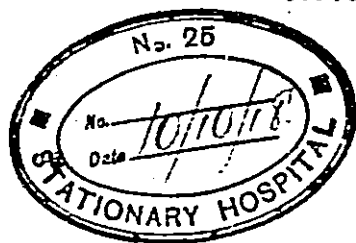
