He was in D.Coy., and in 13th Pltn., of that Coy. I saw him killed at Acroche Wood, near Corbie, when death was instantaneous. Gurney J. 7743 was killed by same shell, some pieces of which killed Brown. Casualty happened in the morning of 8-8-18 at which time we were attacking. I was very close myself at the time. I knew him fairly well, and he came from Sydneyo N.S.W. I cannot give any details of burial, but we held the ground, so he was sure to be buried. Refer to Sgt.McCallum, D.Coy. 34th Battn., who is now in France, for I'm sure he will know details of burials.
