## "Killed 5-10-17"

About this date we were working on Corduroy track near Messines, in evening after tea. Wes hit by piece of H.E.shell in chest. I was S/B at time and was 20 yards away when it happened. I bandaged him up and took him to D/S. He died within 10 mins after getting there. This was 2/3 Kilos from Neuve Eglise. Was buried in Military Cemetery at thes D/S. Did not see burial, as I had to return to duty, but men at D/S told me that they would see to his: burial. Knew him as Benc.
