I know Private. Larous 1. Brown, A. Company, attached to Company H. C. as a Sanitary man; he came from Sydney and was I think a prospector and accustomed to the Bush. He came with the 10th to the 13th Meinforcements from Sydney about the 20th. Coptember 1915. I saw him in the front line trench at Zennebake on September 25th. 1917, his body was carried out of the sap and buried in the rear. I saw the Grave but cannot say whether a Cross was put on the war position was heavily shelled the nort day.

I knew Maurice Brown well. He was wounded very badly in body and legs by a shell in front line trench, Polygon Wood stunt, and died very shortly after being hit - almost immediately. Pte.

Vene (both A.Co.) was killed by same shell and they - Kane and Brown were caried in a shell hole just outside in front of the trench.

Col.Merks ordered the burial.

I saw Brown lying dead but did not actually see casualty or burial.
