Was wounded in the leg on August 7th in the charge from Pope's Hill and was brought back to behind our firing line. This was seen by Sgt. A.M. Garbett, 203, and by Sgt Wiaken, 87, both of the 1st A.L.H. Regt., both of whom told informant, Brown cannot, therefore, be "missing".
