Informant states that about Aug.25th., at Suvla Bay, Boggs was fetching water when on fatigue duty and he was sniped. Informant did not see him shot but a short time afterwards saw his body.

Boggs was about 5'7" in height, had lost some front teeth (upper jaw) was fair and about 25 yrs.old.
