I know he was killed last July 23-27th. Struck by a shell. My informent was 6/8 Ackling who has himself since been killed in action. He had found his wounded and was carrying him down when the shell billed him. This was at Pozieres. I never heard anything of his burial.

A Court of Enquiry was held about June 18th at which I was present, the President being Major Carter, and it was ascertained that Brunskill had been killed in action. He was seen in our front line trench at Pozieres with both legs broken, about July 23rd. On 3 succeeding days very heavy shelling and he was not seen again. He was not in a position to be taken prisoner and could not walk.
