I saw the first two men and the third, whose name I am not sure of. hut I think it was Shielas buried by a shell. was a little above them myself because I was buried before up to the waist and I had scrambled out to a higher level, then this shell came over and buried all three, and two Lewis Guns besides, and the amounition. I scrambled out and was going to dig them out. but I do not think I was quite meself at the time, and then I heard simeone calling for help, and in the next traverse I saw a Segt. buried up to his waist and his less caught in some way underneath, and his face all bleeding, so I dug him ut and then I saw a hand underneath and this was the hand of an officer of the 3rd. brigade Machine Gun. He was got out as well and then I crawled back following the officer, and the Sergt. went another way, but the three men who were buried before we left behind, and I am afraid they will be reported missing. This happened on 26th July. Tuesday afternoon, about 2 o'clock at lozieres I think.
