D/illness 13/11/18

During the evening of November 13th 1918 Pte Britten was accidentally wounded in the abdomen by a revolver shot. At the time of the accident he was visiting a friend at the Voais Batheny and as member of his unit was a witness. He was evacuated to the 3rd Ed. Qld. Ambulance where he died of his injury three days later. He was buried with full military honors in the Military Cemetery at Ripoli Synei.
