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We have received an answer from the 0.C. of the . 61st Casualty Clearing Station about -

1085a Ptc. T.R. CURRAN, 35th Battalion, A.I.P. He said "He was admitted to this C.C.S. on 7-5-18, suffering from a ponetrating bonb wound of the chest. He died on the following day. He left no message and prosed away quite peacefully. The burial took place in the Local Military Cemetery."
