It is hereby certified that there is here produced the grave card of the Ref. II.D. according to which the Australian Prisoner of War Deakin, Percy, Pte, soldier of the 28th Btl. Austr. Imp. Force, 2nd Division, 7 Bde, died at Caudry on 28th August 1918 and was buried in the Communal Cemetery single grave 125, at Caudry.

Dear Sir

We have received your inquiry
for your brother No 2022 Pte Percy Deakin

26th Btn A.I.F., and are very sorry that
we have only bad news to send you.

His name has appeared on a German death
list, dated September 30th, as having died
a prisoner of war on August 28th, and having
been buried at Gemeindefriedhof in Coudry.

We have had cases in which mistakes
have been made but they have been
rare and we fear that this sad news
must be true.

We can only assure you of our deepest
sympathy in your loss and sorrow and
be sure that if we hear anything further we
shall let you know.
