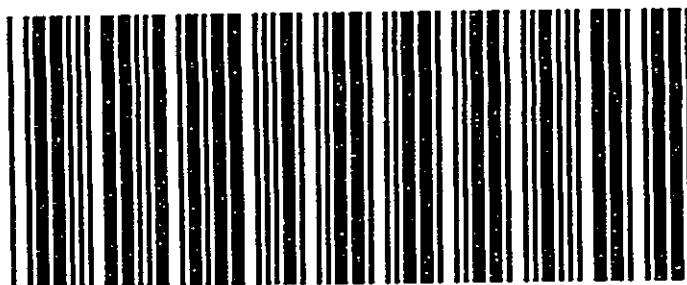

Dear Sirs,

I have received a letter from
some friends in Australia, asking me
if I can find out for them anything
about their son.

They received a field card from him
from France in August last, saying
"all well"; and on September 14th, 1916,
received a wire from the Peace Records
at Melbourne, stating that he was
wounded. Since then, they have been
unable to hear anything.

His name, rank etc: is —

Lance-corp: Stanislaus G. Donnellan, 3747,

R^g Coy: 13th Batt: 4th Brigade,
Australian Imperial Forces.

If you could let me know anything
about him, so that I could communicate
with his parents, I should be
very grateful.
