"Killed 9th Oct. 1917."

"He was transferred to the 20th A.I.F. about 10 days before he was killed at Broodseinde Ridge on 9th Oct. 1917. He was originally missing but his body was found later and buried near the spot by men of another battalion. He was a great chum of mine and I have written to his Mother who has recieved all available information and his brother (who is I believe, in France with the Aust. A.S.C.) has also all details. The "6th Coy" is a mistake, he belonged to the 5th M.G.C. A.I.F. His name was John and his number 164. His Mother's address is "Sorrento", Glassop Street, Balmain, Sydney.
