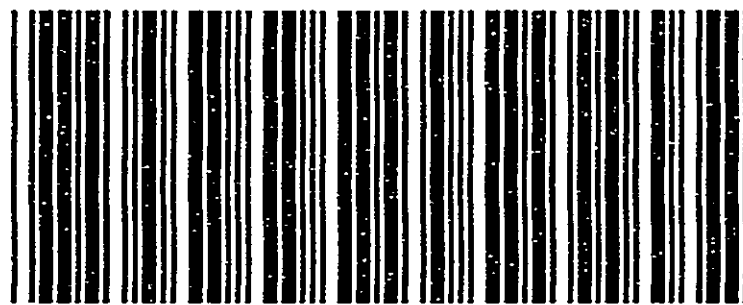

His death took place during a serious battle in the Romani Campaign. Elliot is buried near Bir el Abd - Roughly 2 miles from Railway Station. Every effort is being made to obtain a photograph of his grave and if successful same will follow on.
