The shell blow the whole traverse in and Barnes and his brother Ellis were killed. We dus d. Barnes out; I know that his body was buried at the back of the traverse. I was called away and do not know what happened to his brother's body or to Ellis. I was in the same plateen as both the brothers Barnes. I know Ellis also. He brother is in pltn. I too.
