I saw Doorey C Coy killed instantly alongside of me at Villers Bretonneux about 5 a.m. soon after we hopped over by machine gun bullet through throat. He was again hit by shell but the bullet killed him. It was near the main road. I had a look at him and saw that he was dead. He was buried where he fell by Lieut Smith. He was my batman and was an absolutely game little chap. Doorey:- Small, dark, a married man.
