"DIED OF WOUNDS 8-8-18"

Of B.Coy.H.Q. On 8th Aug. this side of Harbonnieres in our advance. He was hit by piece of shell in knee. I did not see him to speak to, but Stretcher Bearer who took him out said he was conscious and that the wound, though nasty, did not seem to be a dangerous one.

We heard of his death, but know nothing of burial. He was mate of mine - came from near Mansfield - Christian name "Mat".
