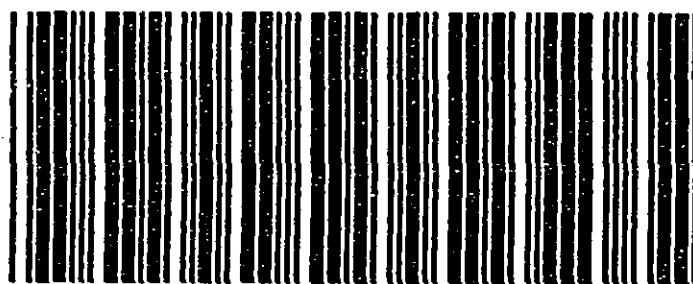

I saw Anderson C. Coy., in the trench near Messines when he was wounded. Things were quiet at the time and we heard an explosion which we took to be a bomb and then he was found wounded no one seemed to know how. He was taken back by S/Bearers and we heard he died at Bailleul but I don't know of his burial.
