# D/W Oct 15th 1917, Dets D/B.

Aley was in my plateen and section - Rifle Grenadiers. His number was 609. He was wounded in supports to the left of Polygon Wood about 185h-20th of October. We were in a trench just behind a pillbox which was being shelled pretty heavily. Aley was at the end of my section with a man named, whartin. A shell bebed on the parapet and \*\*Lilea\*\*\*them both. We got them out - Martin first, who went down the line with shell shock. Aley was hit in the chest and www leg, and was carried down to the Reg iid Post. which is all I know. He was an English chap, short and nuggety, but a fine good fellow.
