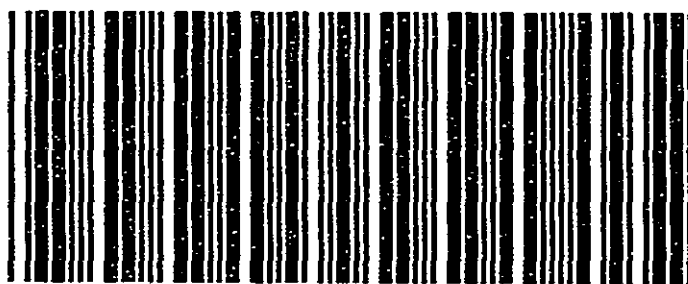

"Missing July 29th"

He is my brother. "Thomas" is his name. He was in A. Coy. 4th platoon. He was of medium build - dark complexion - 26 years. He came from Emerald, N.S.W. He enlisted in Queensland. The Sgt. Major told me that he saw my brother at Dressing Station - he saw he was slightly wounded in the hip and arm - he saw he was a walking case. I have not heard from my brother since he has been in France. The Sgt. Major knew him well. I can rely on his statement. I would like enquiries made.
