In further enswer to your inquiry for details of the death of your nephew No 2046 Pte. W.Braid. S8th Bettelion,

we deeply regret to inform you of evidence which has been received from men of his unit, one of whom witnessed the onsmalty.

No 555 L/Sgt. G.S. Grover, who was in the Horton Hospital, Epsom, reported that he use told that Pte.Braid, had been killed instantanteously by a Soling shell, while standing in the door of his dugout in a support trench at Hunter Avenue, Ploegstmert Wood, Messines.

No 595 Spt. A.F.Maddell, who was in the Frd Australian Auxiliary Hospital, Dartford reported that he saw Fte.Braid, lying dead at Floegsteert Wood on 18.5.17. He had been killed instantaneously by a shell and is buried behind Ploegsteert Wood. No 2111 Cpl.E.Miller, in this same hospital, gave similar evidence. He saw your nephew killed instantly by a shell when behind the firing line at Regent Street, at Ploegsteert, and he refers us to enother man of the unit, for perticulars of his burial.

We have applied to the Graves Registration Eureau for a photograph of his grave which will be forwarded as soon as circumstances will permit direct to his next of kin, and as soon as we receive further details, of his casualty we shall advice you see frusting that it will be some confort to know that his death was instantaneous.
