"Sgt Angus was taken prisoner by the enemy on the Canal at Mienport on July 10th/17. I saw his name on the list of prisoners sent over by the enemy about 10 days or a fortnight ago. The Germans attacked us broke up all our posts with their barrage and we had to retire. It was about 4.30 p.m. when I saw the list it had just been received from the enemy".
