Re Pte. Atkin. I am to inform you that he was admitted to this hospital on the 21st June suffering from a severe gun-shot wound head and compound fractured skull.

He died on the 18th ultimo at 4.15 p.m. and was buried at St. Sever Cemetery, Rouen, on July 20th 1918 in Grave No. 4703.
