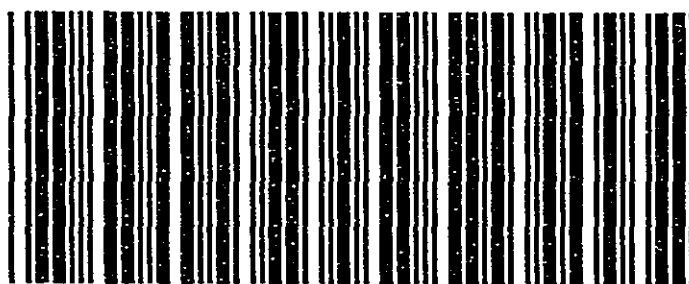

"Killed 6.5.17."

I saw him wounded at Bullecourt on the morning of 5th May 1917. He was hit by shell fragments in the neck and back and only lived about a quarter of an hour. He was conscious all the while and was constantly calling for his mother. He was only quite a lad and asked me if I came through alright to write to her in Gippsland telling her of the casualty. I do not know place of burial as I was wounded soon after myself. This man's name is not included in the Official enquiry list.
