On about May 28th, Bull was helping to remove the wounded at Monash Gully near Anzac, when he was shot by a sniper and subsequently died. He was buried in the Cemetery at Anzac.

Was usually assisting in Orderly room but on this occasion sometime in May, date uncertain, he was helping to carry a wounded man on a stretcher from Quins Post down Monash Gully to the Dressing Station when he was shot through the head by sniper.

Thomas Henry (Died of Wounds May 29 - Details)

Causey had been taking wounded down to the beach on stretchers and as Causey had to go elsewhere, Bull took his place to do a turn but was at once hit in the back of the head by snipers; he was a hopeless case and died not long afterwards.

W.W. Brown of 3 Co. was assisting with the stretcher. Place called Shrapnel Gully.
