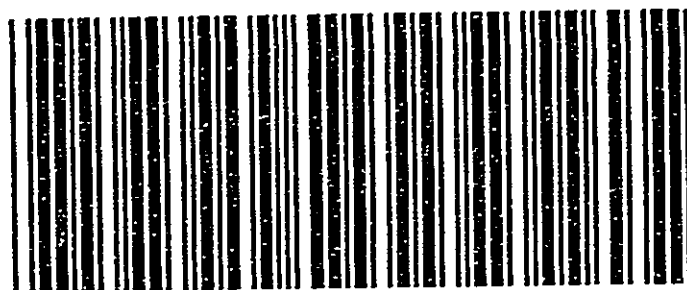

"Headquarters B. Coy, Runner names" - Goulding (initials not of 42nd Bn know) had D.C.M. distinction, is buried at bottom of Broodseinde Ridge on left of railway about 20 yards back from 42nd Bn trench. He was killed about on Oct: 5th by a whizbang which took his legs both and both arms, he died immediately. I buried him, there is no cross erected on his grave, but it is easily found. It is near the railway.
