I know Private Robert J. Grant, D. Company. He had the M.M. and we enlisted in Tasmania; between 20 and 30. Inirly tall and well built. fair, clean shaten. I saw him being carried out on July 4th. 1918 in the Hamel stant, and saw his grave after in the Crony Military Cometery. I made the cross for his grave and placed it on the grave.

"Died of Wounds 5/7/18."

Of D. Company, 14th Platoon. At Hamel on the 4th July just at start of our attack, was hit by piece of phosphorus ahell which exploded his cartridge belt - was hit all over. Wes taken to R.A.P. and then to Casualty Clearing Station at Crony where he died. I was 4 or five yards away when he was wounded. Was buried in Military Cemetery at Crony, cross erected. I have seen his grave, which is well looked after. Christian arem Bob. Ceme from Tesmania - was a fine soldier.
