"I knew Casualty. He was a slight built man, about 5 ft. 8 ins. fair complexion, about 24 years of age, known as "Norman". He embarked from Australia with the 3rd Bncts. of the 15th Light Horse. Casualty was at Mont Ebrahain during the advance. He was going forward in the attack and as he reached the top of the Mount a machine gun bullet penetrated his breast killing him instantly. I was about 50 yds. away at the time and I saw his body soon afterwards. He was buried where he fell and there was a cross erected over the grave."
