### R. February 1st, 1917.

He was in my Coy and Battn(A.I). I think his people live in Kent and if I had their address I would write them with details. I tried to find their address. Cpl.Jack Henderson of A.IV (formerly in A.I) up line told me he was with Baskins when he was shot through head by a sniper and killed instantly at Guidecourt on night of February 1/8, 1917. All got bombed out of the trench an hour or two later so that his body had to be left there. We regained ground about a month later and held it.
