

I did not see the cesualty, but saw him on stretcher when being taken back to dressing station. He had been hit in leg which had been badly fractured above knee. He was hit by a piece of shell and casualty happened near Corbie. I knew him fairly well, though I was in a different Battn. from him. He died on the way to Fld.Amb., living about one hour, and being conscious when I saw him. He then seemed cheerful, but collapsed shortly afterwards from lows of blood. He was buried near Corbie, but I did not see his grave, nor can I refer to anyone for further details.
