He was in D Co., L.G.S. L/Opl. Shephard, H. ~~was~~  
~~was~~, O Co., L.G.S. told me that he had seen  
him blown to pieces by a shell on the date mentioned.  
His remains were not buried. I knew him well: he came  
from Beaufort, Victoria. Shephard was claimed  
by his parents on account of having two brothers  
killed, and has gone back to Footscray, Melbourne,  
Victoria.
