These men were in the 33rd Battn. A.Coy. 3rd Pltn., a Lewis gun team, Swilks being No.1. I am the L.G. Coy.Cpl. and saw the team go out from about a mile behind the line at Morlincourt early in May, 1918, about 11 p.m. None of them returned.
