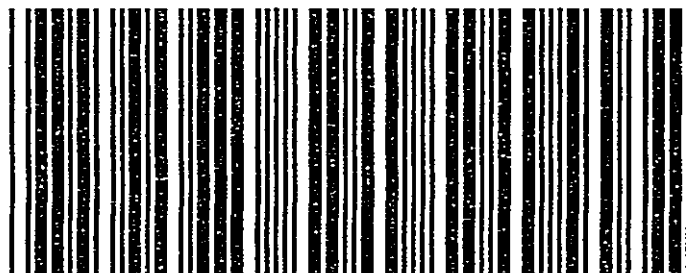

I produce a letter from No. 3802, Pt. S.E. Knowles of D.Co. 14th Australians, who is a prisoner of war in the Internment Camp, Wahn, Germany, sent to 5247, Sgt. J. Scarff, D.Co. 14th Australians, who is with the Battalion now, in which he states that the above named men are prisoners of war in Germany. The man referred to as "Snow" is Pto. Willmott of C.Co. who was employed by Messrs. Angles as a slaughterman at Footscraig, Melbourne, and was a well-known football player. The letter is as follows:-

"Dear Sergt. Scarff. Just a few lines hoping this letter finds you well as it leaves me very peckish. I want you to do me a favour by sending me a box of Bully Beef and Anzac Biscuits that is if it is not too much trouble to you you do not really know how bad that we want them if Jack Cottrell has not left their show him this letter Sgt Marshall Sgt. Carver are (Marshall) naked but are in a different place to me. I suppose that you have heard of the affair by this Jim Gunn Sgt. McClintock were.
