

We have written to Pte Greyland's friends in England, also to his friends in Helbourne. The Sister of the ward also wrote and sent a snapshot. Pte Greyland had a very serious injury to the thigh, also an amputation of the leg, Hemmorahge of the injury was the real cause of death, which came on at several different periods. He was a very nice lad and much liked in the ward. We would have been glad to have been able to give you different news of him.
