He was reserve of our M.G.T. He was tall, about 23 or 24 years of age, and dark. He was in C.Co. Sergt. J. Higgins of the 28th Batt., C.Co., now with the Battalion, told me that Carter was killed at Bullecourt on May 2nd or 3rd. He was killed outright by a shell. He had to retire.

I know very little but I do know that he was killed on 3.5.17 and buried on the battlefield. He was about 5'8" blue eyes, rather deep sunken, weak, thin face, slender built, medium hair. Last seen at Bullecourt and I think it is official that he was buried in a shell hole.

I was in the same billets with Carter who was killed at the Cross Roads Armentiers by a bomb from a Taube whilst in a fatigue party and was buried at Erquinghem. I have seen his grave with cross erected. It is alongside Sgt. Bennett's grave (also 28th)
