On a Sunday night in Deadman's Gully, Monach Valley, on May 8 or 9, they went with a charge and Christie's thigh was very badly shattered.

A note was sent to say that he was slowly bleeding to death. So informant sent out stretcher-bearers who said they had got him, and some of his friends said they had seen him going to the dressin station. Christie's identification disc was brought in, and witness saw it. Witness is of opinion that his body was not brought in, but was buried where he fell. He was the only one of the name in the company and witness knew him well. They shared the same tent.

He made a charge on May 2nd and he was badly wounded and left when we retired and he sent a note down to the Battalion asking them to come and fetch him. Pte Seggret got the note. Was not brought in. Died of exposure and was buried during the armistice. The place is called Deadman's Gully and is between Pope's Hill and Quinn's Post.
