Informant states: " I know that on Aug. 20th. in the attack on Hill 60, Galliloli, above went out and did not turn up in the trench-we took & which formed our furthest out front.

There was a big scrub fire caused by shells over the ground that afternoon and evening and a lot of men burnt there.

Christie was included in the Western Mail War Souvenir Supp't, Christmas 1915, in the list of killed in action, and I believe he is dead. He was in my Squadron.
