According to witness Harris was wounded on the Peninsula, went to England, and from there rejoined the Battalion at Tel-el-Kebir, where he gave witness (who was not on the Peninsula) these details. Harris was originally in D. Coy. of the 2nd A. I. F. but has now been transferred to the 13th Battalion, B. Coy.
