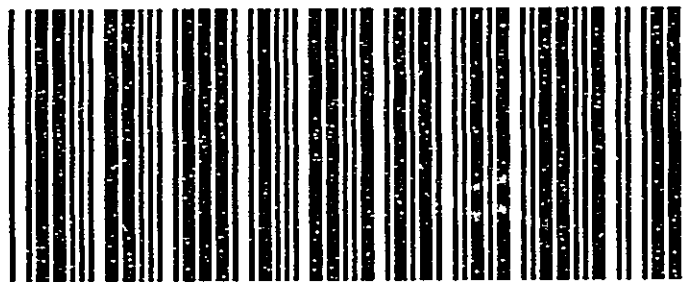

"Died of wounds"

The above named soldier died in this Hospital on October 22nd 1917 from wounds received in action 9.10.17. On admission to this Hospital on 15th Oct., he was suffering from compound fracture of the right thigh and gangrene had set in. It was necessary to amputate the right leg. A few days later he developed pneumonia and died. He was buried in Wimereux Cemetery.
