I wish to tell you that these two men were buried and no crosses erected owing to our fast movements. They were buried together at the entrance to the village of Templeaux (? Templeux) in front of Reisel. A D/S is noticed as you enter the village on the Peronne side and the graves are situated in a field at the cross-roads as you enter the village. There are about 8 or 10 other graves there, on which the graves were only marked with indelible pencil, as in the case of these two.
