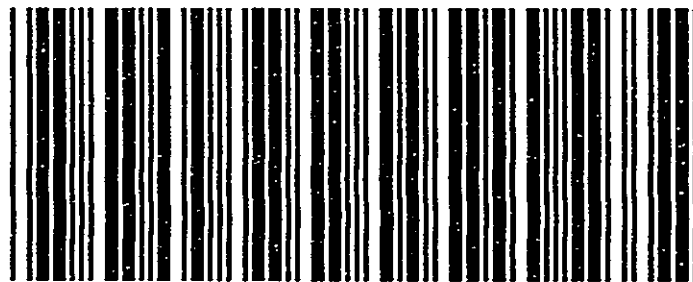

I am in receipt of your letter of 2nd inst., about 4482 Pte. LESLIE DUNN, 46th Battalion. A.I.F. and 426 Pte. F.P. MORTIMER, 5th Div. Ammunition Column. A.F.A., and regret that through incorrect entries from A.I.F. Headquarters we should have troubled you unnecessarily. Pte. Dunn died at the 2nd General Hospital, B.E.F. and not at the 2nd Australian General Hospital, as we believed.

Pte. Mortimer was admitted to the 40th Stationary B.E.F. and not to the 14th Stationary Hospital as we informed and we have since learned of his arrival in England.

With many apologies for troubling you and with thanks for your kindness in making enquiries.

With reference to your enquiry for details of the death and burial of your brother - 4482 Pte. L. DUNN, 46th Battalion, A.I.F. We deeply regret to have to confirm the news of his death which occurred on 18.10.18, at the 2nd General Hospital, H. B. F. from broncho pneumonia. There are at present no further particulars available, but we have written to the O.C. of the Hospital and will advise you as soon as we receive his reply.

We will also apply to on your behalf to the Graves Dept A.I.F. Headquarters for a photograph of his grave and a copy will be sent as soon as it is available to his next of kin in Australia.

We should be glad if you would advise/when you are returning to Australia so that we may know when to discontinue writing to you in England. We will then send all information to our office in Spencer Block, Queens Street, BRISBANE where we advise you to apply on your arrival.

the 21.10.18.

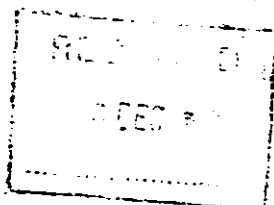
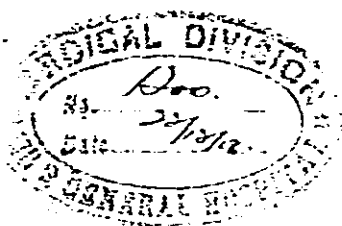
