All the above men were in the Lewis Gun section and were in the stunt at Passchendaele. It was considered certain in the Battn. that they were all killed by shell on Oct. 12th. I did not see it happen although only 30 yards away, but was told by 144 Pte. H. Newman A. Coy. 34th Battn. France. He was one of the gun team and was with them at the time. Newman was wounded and can give some more details, re above men.
