"I am sure Crawford was killed on May 3rd, with a man named Jim Fry. This was Bullecourt on May 3rd when the attack was over. Crawford and Fry, as well as myself, were acting as stretcher bearers and they were both killed instantaneously by a shell burst. He was somewhere about 40, abt. 5ft 4", gray haired, appeared to have worked hard. Had been an engineer at Small & Shattels, Engineers, Johnson St, Fitzroy, Melbourne. He showed me a photograph of his wife and I think 3 children. His home address was North Fitzroy, Melbourne."
