M. April 11th 1917.

L/C Chaffey in the 14th is my brother. I went over to the camp of the 14th - it would be some time after April 19th - to ask about him and was directed to a mate of his who they said was with him and could tell me. I can't remember what his name was though he told me. He said he saw Chaffey with others in the hands of the enemy in their trenches, and that he did not seem to be wounded. I went then to Lt Jacka my brother's officer, but he told me that they had had no information about him.
