I remember seeing "Ted" Colquhoun, D. Coy, XIV or XV Platoon at work in the same party as myself on a road at Baire near Albert up till about 20th January. As the initials of the man who is reported as missing are "E.E." the presumption is that one of his names was Edward and that he is therefore to be identified with "Ted" Colquhoun.
